

Footpaths Report March 2025

This has been a busier month with five reports and action taken on four of them.

The stiles reported by Melanie at Redlands Farm Barkby are not on the prescribed route of the right of way. It would appear that field boundaries have been moved. The local authority is in negotiations to have the path restored to its correct position which will only require one stile/gate.



This gate reported by Andy at Portals Farm, Cold Newton would not open.

The PROW team have been in contact with the Landowner/Occupier to have the matter resolved



This 'stile' on the Rutland Water Peninsula was reported by Sallyann.

Rutland County Council are aware of the issue and are in the process of having a kissing gate replace it.

Ian has reported on two gates on bridelway D2 Cold Newton. The local authority has been in contact with the owner/occupier over the issue
